Inmaris Group Files Claim Against Ukraine

Hamburg, June 23, 2008 – Supported by Luther Rechtsanwaltsgesellschaft, Hamburg-based Inmaris Group sues the Ukraine before ICSID (International Centre for the Settlement of Investment Disputes) arbitration court.

The claim of the Hamburg companies Inmaris Perestroika Maritime Services GmbH, Inmaris Windjammer Sailing GmbH i.L., Inmaris Windjammer Chartering GmbH i.L. and Windjammer Beteiligungsgesellschaft mbh & Co. KG ("Inmaris Group)" draws upon the investment protection agreement under international law between Germany and Urkaine.

The dispute around the Ukraine training sailer "Khersones" operated by Inmaris group since the mid 90s finally initiated the legal action. The ship is detained in the Ukrainian port Kerch since April 2006, thus forcing two companies of the Inmaris group into insolvency. The companies and liquidator Dr. Sven-Holger Undritz are now suing for damages.
